SilverNet Infrastructure patch cables are made using OM3 50/125 + OM4 50/125 Multimode Fibre and OS2 9/125 Singlemode Fibre UPC polished duplex LC connectors at both ends of the cable allow for the connection of the most common network technologies that use SFP transceivers.
